One, two or four players can play each team. The game features a wide variety of weapons, including the M56 and M59 light machine guns, the MP7 submachine gun, the SR-25 assault rifle, the M1014 shotgun, and the M79 grenade launcher. Many of these weapons can be seen in the movie, some are unique to the game. There are also 4 vehicle modes which offer different levels of destruction, while playing as a vehicle. In addition to the main multiplayer modes, the game offers a Freeplay mode in which the player can experience the game from a first-person view. Story After years of conflict, the extraterrestrials known as the "Genestealers" have driven the planet's human population to the brink of extinction. The Colonial Marines task force, led by the unit's commander, Ripley, successfully fought off the Genestealers in their last remaining stronghold, proving humanity's resilience. Seven years later, Ripley encounters a young man, Carter Burke, who claims to have been rescued by the Marines from the planet. After being rescued, he refuses to tell Ripley anything about the Genestealers or why the Marines need to be called back. Soon after, Ripley is contacted by a Senator who is willing to fund the Marines' next mission to Genestealer City. As Ripley prepares for their return to the planet, she encounters her daughter (who is pregnant with Burke's child) and Burke's

mother. Burke's mother is also unwilling to tell Ripley anything about the Genestealers and Burke's role in their plans. During their mission, Ripley and Burke are ambushed by a new alien form called the Berserker. Shortly after, they are rescued by a mercenary crew that Burke was working for. When Ripley returns to Earth, she is contacted by Burke, who says that he has been following her mission, and that he knows more about the Genestealers than he was willing to tell her. After hearing his story, Ripley accepts to help Burke destroy the Genestealer civilization. Development In March 2007, a trailer for the game was released, and details about the game and gameplay were released a month later. It was later revealed that the game would feature non-linear levels and be a third-person shooter.
